Frogs

Learn about frogs that live in Wisconsin, their amazing adaptations, and then try to catch one!

(Grades prek, k, 1, 2, 3)

Survival Skills

Learn the basics of survival by building a shelter, and starting a fire without matches.

(Grades 2, 3)

Archery

Learn the parts of the bow and arrow, and basic shooting techniques.

(Grades 2, 3)

Boating

Journey around the pond in our row boats, while looking for creatures like turtles basking in the sun.

(Grades prek, k, 1, 2, 3)

Birds of a Feather

This is an introduction to birds for the younger learner. Topics include bird basics, birding, study their habitat and feed the birds.

(Grades prek, k, 1)

Water Exploration

Put on some boots and join us as we walk through the pond looking for critters. Students will simulate a predator and prey relationship

(Grades 1, 2, 3)

Nature Detectives

Student detectives will walk the nature trail looking for signs of wildlife including insects, birds and mammals.

(Grades prek, k, 1, 2, 3)
